### **Exam Pattern:**

The entrance exam will consist of of multiple choice questions (MCQs) based on general studies, Current affairs and Analytical Skills and 5 subjective questions of 10 marks each. Duration: 3 hours

### Syllabus for UPSC and APSC Entrance Test

**GENERAL STUDIES- Objective(MCQ) Booklet-I(Total Marks:200): No. of Questions: 100 [80 Questions from PART-A Syllabus & 20 Questions from PART-B Syllabus(CSAT)]**

#### **PART-A**

- i. Current events of national and international importance.
- ii. History of India and Indian National Movement.
- iii. Indian and World Geography-Physical, Social, Economic Geography of India and the World.
- iv. Indian Polity and Governance-Constitution, Political System, Panchayati Raj, Public Policy, Rights issues etc,
- v. Economic and Social Development-Sustainable Development, Poverty, Inclusion, Demographics, Social Sector Initiatives, etc.
- vi. General issues on Environment ecology, Bio-Diversity and Climate Change- that do not require subject specialization.
- vii. General Science.

**Note: 30-35% questions in General Studies Paper I will be related to Assam.**

## **PART-B (CSAT)**

- i. Comprehension.
- ii. Interpersonal skills including communication skills.
- iii. Logical reasoning and analytical ability.
- iv. Decision making and problem solving.
- v. General mental ability.
- vi. Basic numeracy (numbers and their relations, orders of magnitude, etc.) (Class X level), Data Interpretation (charts, graphs, tables, data sufficiency etc.) (Class X level)

## **GENERAL STUDIES- Subjective (Booklet-II)- Total Marks-50**

- i. **SYLLABUS SAME AS PART-A ABOVE**
- ii. **No. of Questions: 05( each carry 10 marks)**
- iii. **Word Limit: 150 words per question**
- iv. **All questions are mandatory**

## **Personal Interview-100 Marks**

### **General Instructions:**

**Penalty for wrong answers:-There will be penalty for wrong answers marked by a candidate in the objective type question paper (Booklet-I).**

- i. There are four alternatives for the answer to each question. One fourth of the marks assigned to that question will be deducted as penalty(0.50 per wrong answer)
- ii. If a candidate gives more than one answer, it will be treated as wrong answer even if one of the given answer happens to be correct and there will be same penalty as above to that question.
- iii. If a question is left blank i.e., no answer is given by the candidate, there will be no penalty for that question.
- iv. Candidates should hand over the OMR sheet and Booklet-II to the invigilator and permitted to keep Booklet-I after completion of the exam.
- v. Total marks is 250 where, Booklet-I carries 200 marks and Booklet-II carries 50 marks and Time allotted is 3hours.
