## **Objective:**

The objective of this paper is to develop basic communication, reading and speaking skills in modern Persian. Students will continue to develop linguistic competence through a curriculum that builds upon the vocabulary and grammar introduced in **FYUG** 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. The course follows a thematically organised and integrative approach to Persian language and culture.

#### **Learning Outcome:**

By the end of the Semester  $1^{st}$  and  $2^{nd}$  student will be able to:

- This course is designed to help students develop the basic skills of reading, writing, listening and speaking Persian, while incorporating knowledge of the Persian culture. Language technologies will assists students while they learn the script and phonology of the Persian alphabet.
