The students took part in the feedback enthusiastically and gave their honest opinion. The feedback was collected on the parameters : Course content, Coverage of syllabus, Load of syllabus, Curriculum delivery, Inspiration for further studies, Extracurricular activities, Infrastructure facilities, Availability of study material, Adequacy of infrastructure for Courses having Lab equipment. The responses have been recorded on a five point scale: Excellent, Very good, Good, Fair and Poor. The responses were studied thoroughly and are represented in the following Tables:

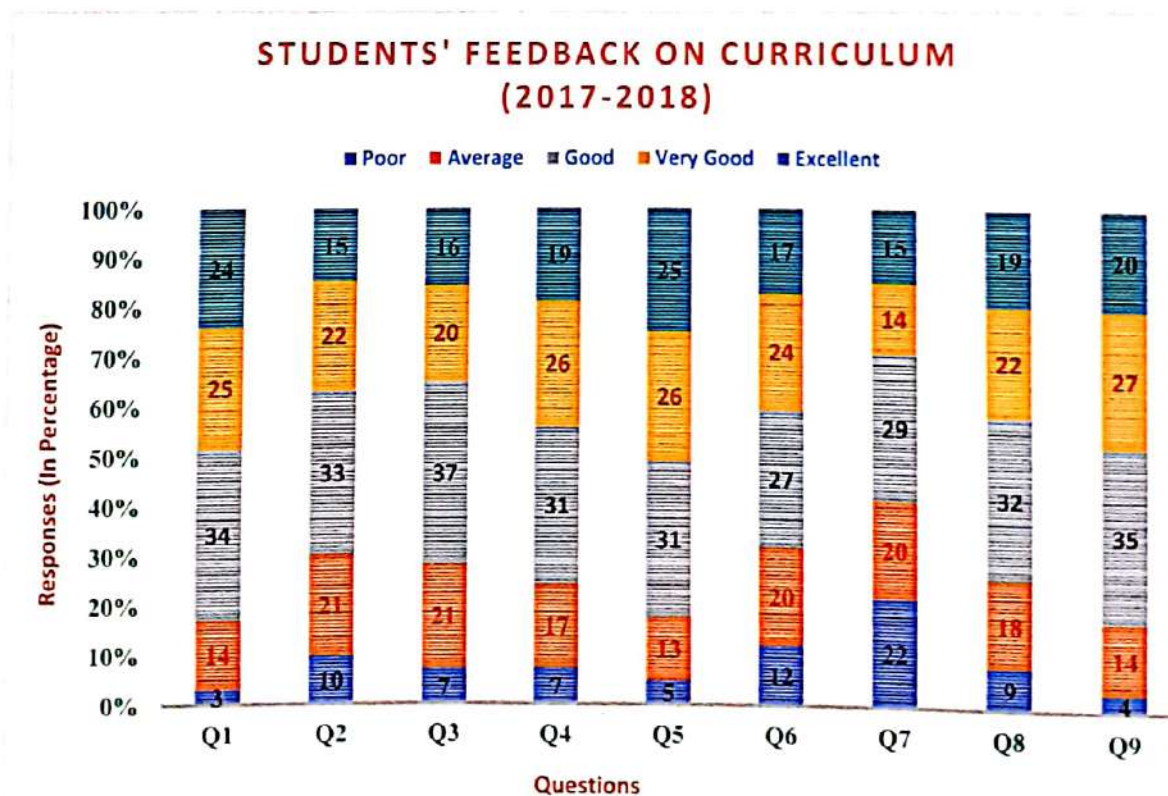

### B. Diagrammatic Analysis of Students' Feedback



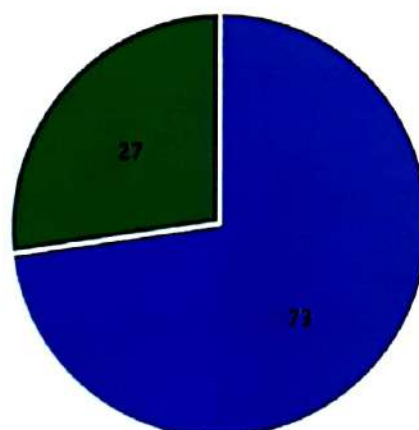
